



Dear Parents and Caregivers

Thank you for looking at our Centre.

What your child needs:

- **PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU LABEL ALL OF YOUR CHILD'S BELONGINGS.**
- Children learn through play, therefore the clothes that your child wears should enable them to paint, climb, run, dig and be involved in messy play without feeling inhibited because of their clothing.
- Shoes appropriate for climbing and running, preferably not thongs or strappy sandals.
- A wide brimmed hat, no cord, for outdoor play and clothing that covers their shoulders.
- A water bottle – labelled with child's name
- Nappies/pull-ups if required.
- A set of spare clothes.
- Bottles of milk.
- Comforters for rest time e.g. dummy, blanket.
- **No Toys**

What we provide:

- **All meals** and **bed linen** will be provided.
- All wipes, sunscreen and insect repellent will be provided.

If your child has any *allergies, special dietary needs, illnesses, fears* etc that we should be aware of please let us know as soon as possible so we can make your child's experience as enjoyable and comfortable as possible.

Our daily routine

A copy of our daily routine is in the Handbook. Please keep in mind that this may change slightly due to weather etc. We also like to be flexible and follow the children's interests and needs.

As part of your child's routine upon their arrival at the centre please ensure you:

- **Sign your child in on Oasis in the front foyer**
- Place your child's bag inside any locker in their room and add their name tag
- Apply sunscreen on arrival
- Place your child's drink bottle inside (if the children are inside) or outside (if the children are playing outside)
- Place child's hat on if the children are outside.

When departing the centre:

- **Sign your child out**
- Collect **all** your child's belongings
- Talk to an educator to find out about your child's day and to ensure staff know your child is leaving

Family Input

Through collaborating and communicating with each family we will assist them to develop a sense of belonging at Morisset Children's Centre; we feel this is vital to high quality care. We actively seek out families' values, knowledge, children's routines, and care needs to implement into our program.
